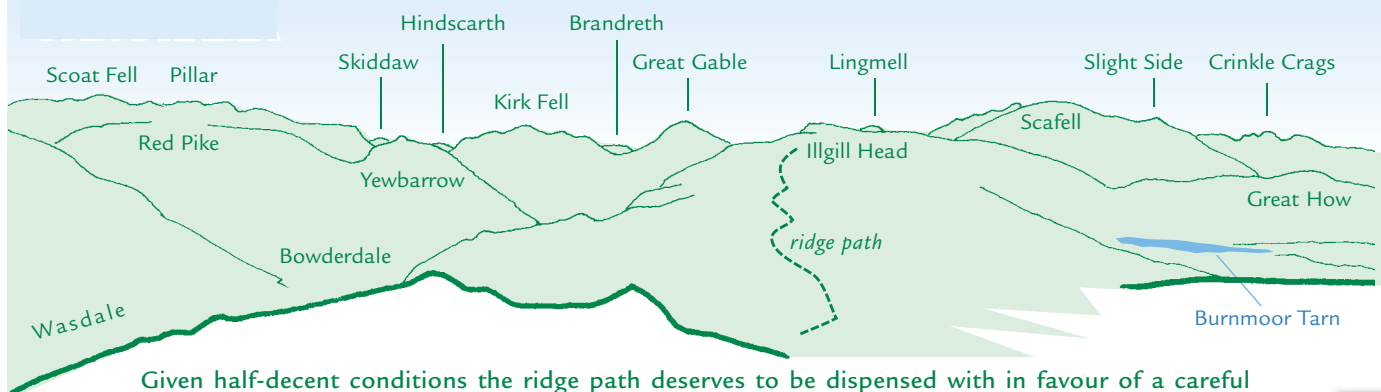


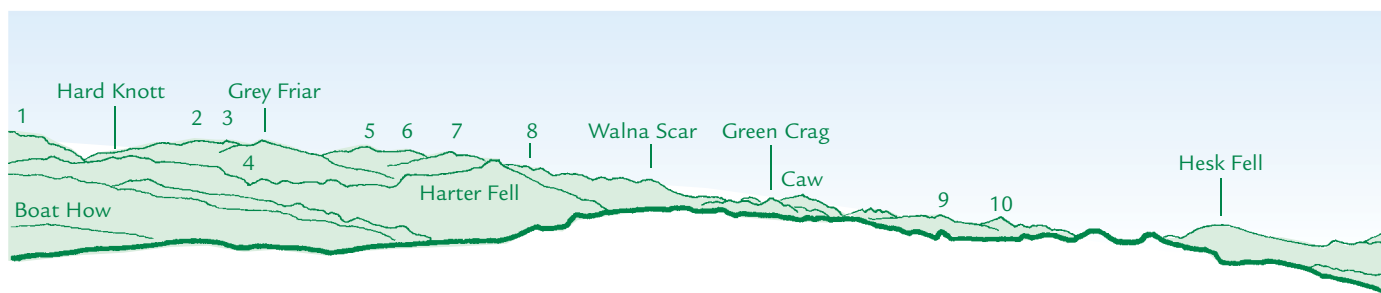
PANORAMA from Whin Rigg (GR152034) 536m

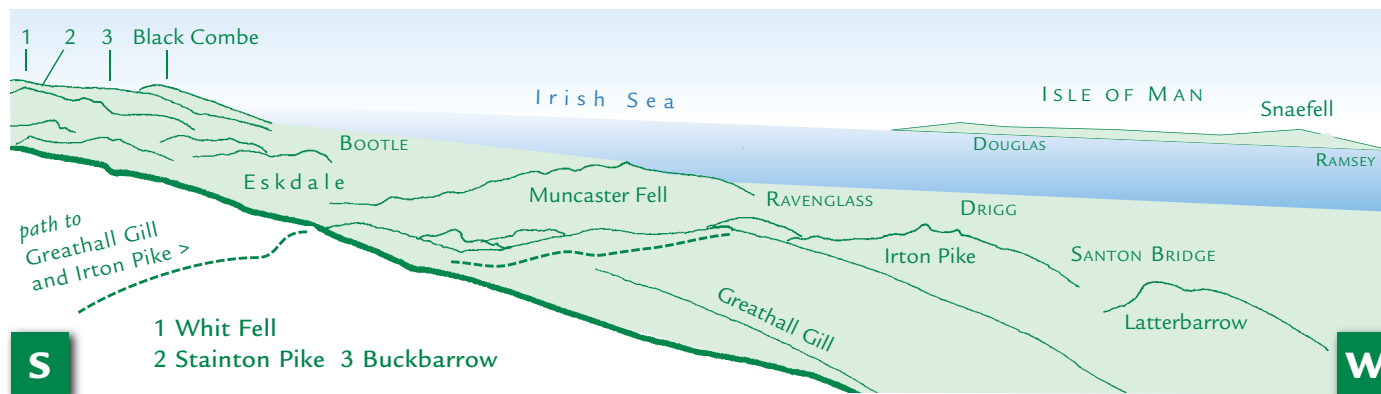

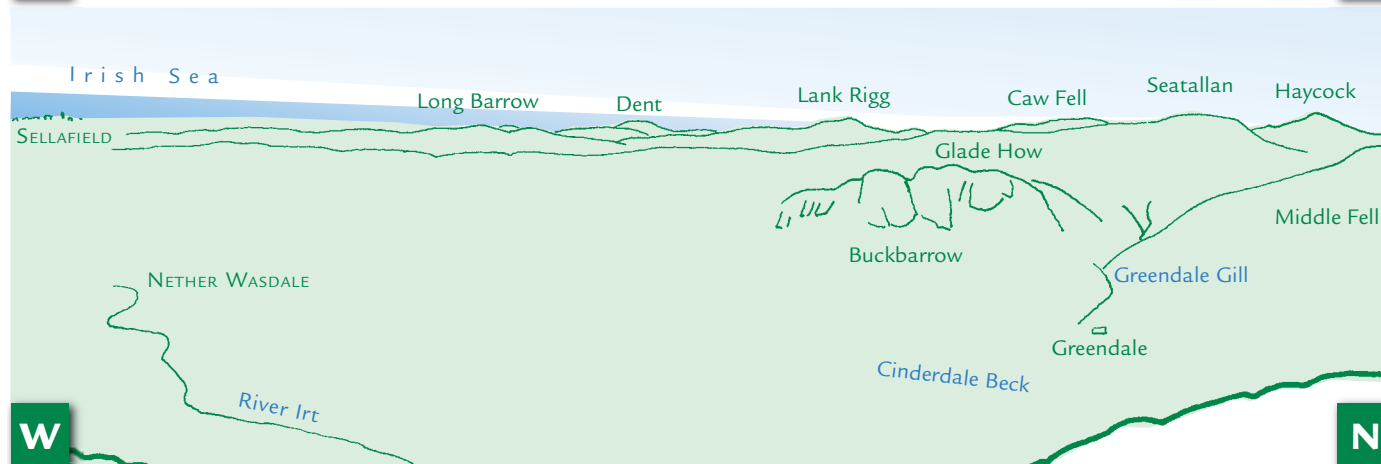
